The Pine Hill Baptist Church Scholarship was established in 1998 through a donation from the Pine Hill Baptist Church of Cheektowaga, NY. Upon the sale of the church property, the congregation deemed a portion of the proceeds to be used to continue the ministry of Pine Hill Baptist by providing financial gifts to area students. The purpose of this gift is to help college students meet the expenses of higher education.

Applicants must be accepted to attend a 2 or 4 year accredited college as a full time student, maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher, be a resident of New York State, and a member of a church. Recipients will be selected based upon their commitment to their church, a strong faith and active involvement in their community. The one-year award of \$1000 will be made with half of the scholarship given prior to the start of the fall semester and half prior to the start of the spring semester.

Instructions to Applicants: Complete the application form and return it along with the requested documents listed below to **First Baptist Church of East Aurora by June 14, 2025.**

Applicants may be asked to meet with the Scholarship Committee. Recipients of the scholarship will be asked to attend the presentation of the award during a worship service.
